## WHO CAN JUDGE?

- Individuals with experience in marketing, management, hospitality, finance, entrepreneurship, sales, human resources, travel and tourism, retail and accounting
- Must be 21+ years old
- Role Play and Case Study Events will test prior to conference, interview in person (face-to-face)
- Written Events document evaluated prior to conference, presentation in person (face-to-face)

## ROLE PLAY EVENTS

### Interview Only

Students will review the role play scenario, 10 minutes preparation, present with you in the role-play. Judges evaluate the role-play to determine students advancing to the final round of competition.

The Preliminary Judges will see up to 12 students. The judges will use the rubric to evaluate the role-play. The scores from the role-play will be added to the student exam scores to find the top 3 students in each section. Those students will then have a Finals Judge with a new role play scenario. The final judge will evaluate the finals role-play. The scores from that role-play will be added to the exam scores. This score will determine the places of the top 9 students in each event.

PRELIMINARY Judges will meet with students on **February 27, 2023** and review/evaluate students assigned to them. This should take approximately 4 hours of time.

FINALS Judges will meet with students on **February 28, 2023** to role-play and evaluate students assigned to them. This should take approximately 3 hours of time.

## CASE STUDY EVENTS

### Interview Only

Students will review the case-study scenario, 30 minutes preparation, present with you in the case-study. Judges evaluate the case-study to determine teams advancing to the final round of competition.

The Preliminary Judges will see up to 8 teams. The judges will use the rubric to evaluate the case-study. The scores from the case-study will be added to the exam scores to find the top 2 teams in each section. Those teams will then have a Finals Judge with a new case-study scenario. The finals judge will evaluate the finals case-study. The scores from finals case-study will be added to the team exam scores. This score will determine the places of the top 6 teams in each event.

PRELIMINARY Judges will meet with teams on **February 27, 2023** to review/evaluate teams assigned to them. This should take approximately 4 hours of time.

FINALS Judges will meet with teams on **February 28, 2023** to evaluate teams assigned to them. This should take approximately 3 ½ hours of time.

## WRITTEN EVENTS

### Written Portion and Presentation

Written Project Evaluations: Students will submit their projects online by **January 27, 2023**. Judges will then be able to begin evaluating this portion of competition.

Presentations Evaluations: Students will present their project on **February 28, 2023**. Judges will evaluate the presentation.

Scores for the written portion and the presentation are combined to determine the winning teams. Some events have an exam component as well.
