FCCLA Dress Code

FCCLA members and advisers represent an outstanding student organization and should project the image of a leader. STAR Events participants are expected to adhere to the published dress code for all general sessions, workshops, and the STAR Events Recognition Session. For participation in competition, follow event specifications for dress, and wear appropriate clothing for the nature of the presentation. If attending conference activities before or immediately after a STAR Events presentation, be prepared to change into clothing that meets the conference dress code. Guests and judges are also asked to adhere to the dress code guidelines.

Failure to adhere to the Dress Code will result in students not being able to participate in STAR events or not being allowed on stage during the sessions.

MANDATORY ATTIRE FOR GENERAL SESSIONS / BUSINESS SESSIONS / EXHIBITS / WORKSHOPS / STAR EVENTS RECOGNITION SESSIONS

- FCCLA red blazer (encouraged at all conferences; required at NLC)
- Professional white or black shirt
- Neckwear options can include neckwear from the official emblematic supplier, black or red tie, black or red bow tie, a single strand of pearls, red black, and/or white scarf, or no neckwear
- Black bottoms (slacks, skirt, sheath dress)
- Shoes (black preferred)
- Jeans, t-shirts, and athletic wear are NOT acceptable

Exception: During the STAR Events Recognition Session, Culinary Arts participants can wear their Chef's Attire.

ANY TIME AT THE CONFERENCE WHEN NOT IN A GENERAL SESSION, WORKSHOP OR COMPETING

- Red, black or white polo shirt
- Black dress pants
- Black shoes

ADVISERS/ CHAPERONES/ GUESTS

- Business professional
- · Jeans, t-shirts, and athletic wear are NOT acceptable

STAR EVENT PARTICIPANTS

STAR Events participants are expected to adhere to the published dress code. For participation in competition, follow event specifications for dress, and wear appropriate clothing for the nature of the presentation. If attending conference activities before or immediately after a presentation, be prepared to change into clothing that meets the conference dress code.

SPECIAL EVENT ATTIRE - All Attendees

· Casual slacks, shorts, jeans, t-shirts, athletic and tennis shoes

POOL ATTIRE

Swim trunks (no speedos), conservative swimsuit. A shirt or cover-up and shoes must be worn to and from the pool area.

Recourse: Members who are refused entrance to any event will be allowed to change into appropriate attire immediately and participate/compete in the event. Having changed into appropriate attire, members will join the event in progress. No additional time will be given for time missed. Members also have the right to grieve the issue immediately after being refused entrance. Grievance of the Dress Code policy will not be accepted if not received in writing at Competitive Events headquarters within 15 minutes of the infraction in question.
