The qualities of intelligence and ability of all members of Business Professionals of America as they work with dignity in their profession are represented by knowledge. Let us strive to recognize our capabilities and develop ourselves as fully as possible so that we may share in a better tomorrow.  In the knowledge category, there are almost 50 different ways to earn points! These points can be earned by showing your understanding and knowledge of BPA.
Knowledg e Easy	Yuki	The easiest way to get knowledge points is a requirement before even starting your Torch Awards Ceremony. Before you can start your Torch Awards resume at <a href="register.bpa.org/members">register.bpa.org/members</a> , you are required to watch the Torch Introduction Video. Citizenshi p Intro	Alexa	Citizenship, which was formerly known as Patriotism.  This ideal implies proud, honest people interested in the welfare of others. Through Business Professionals of America, we recognize our obligation to our communities, and accept the responsibility of dependable citizenship.  Citizenship has over 40 activities that you can complete to earn points. Most of these are very easy to complete!
Citizenshi p 1	Yuki	Here are some simple activities to earn points.  701: Lead the Pledge of Allegiance (or equivalent) of your country at a BPA chapter function 704: Participate in a political activity outside of BPA (this does not include activities such as homecoming) 709: Attend a county, state, or national legislative session, hearing, or committee meeting (does not include TV programs, but you may attend virtually) Note that you can do this at our CTSO Day at the Roundhouse in January!

		711: Vote in a local (city-wide) government election or a mockelection 712: Vote in a state government election or a mock-election 715: Vote in a national government election or mock-election 718: Visit an art museum, natural history museum, African American history museum or similar facility 724: Participate in an activity that supports military or military families
Earn Points	Jenna	Let's leave with some points in the Citizenship category.  Citizenship 720 allows members to take a virtual tour of a historical building or area. On the screen, are a few QR Codes to take a virtual tour of some historical buildings/areas. We will give everyone about 3 minutes to find a location they would like to tour briefly.
